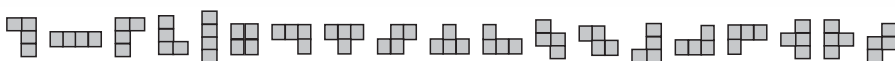
Toss	Read the information and the question. Show how to divide the squares. Find the number of groups.
2	Get 20 squares. Put them in groups of 5. How many groups do you have?
3	Get 20 squares. Make rows of 4. How many rows do you have?
4	Get 12 squares. Put them in groups of 4. How many groups do you have?
5	Get 12 squares. Make rows of 2. How many rows do you have?
6	Get 14 squares. Put them in groups of 2. How many groups do you have?

7	Get 18 squares. Make rows of 2. How many rows do you have?
8	Get 16 squares. Put them in groups of 2. How many groups do you have?
9	Get 24 squares. Make rows of 3. How many rows do you have?
10	Get 15 squares. Put them in groups of 5. How many groups do you have?
11	Get 15 squares. Put them in groups of 3. How many groups do you have?
12	Get 12 squares. Make rows of 3. How many rows do you have?
