Put **1** **2** **3** **4** in a bag.

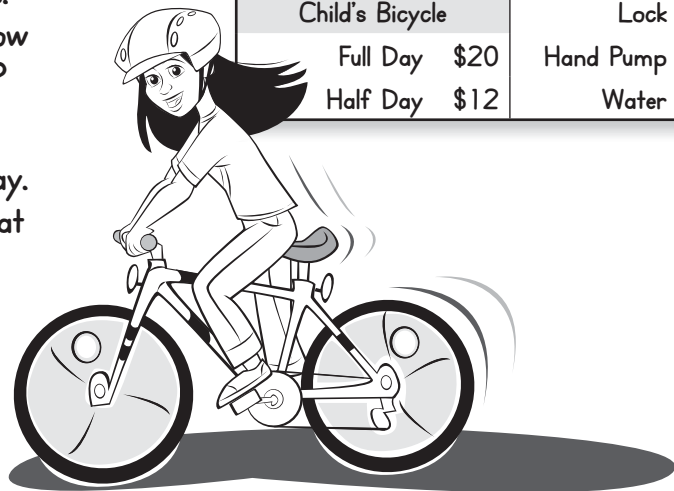
## Repeat for Each Round

- 1** Read the problem.  
Tell your group what you know and what you are asked to find.
- 2** Tell your group what one of the hidden questions is.  
Explain how to answer that question.
- 3** Tell your group about a second hidden question.  
Explain how to answer that question.
- 4** Explain how to solve the problem using the answers to the hidden questions.

- b. Carl paid for his family's accessories. He rented 5 helmets and 5 locks. How much did Carl spend on accessories?
- c. The Johnson family rented 2 adult bicycles and two baby seats for a day. What did the Johnson family spend at the bicycle rental shop?
