To find your job, find the number that matches the tile you chose.

-  **Work with your team to solve the problem.**
-  **Check the answer. Explain why the answer is correct.**

- Kara has quarters and dimes in her bank at home. She has 10 more dimes than quarters. She has \$8 in her bank. How many quarters and dimes does Kara have in her bank?
- How much more money would you earn in a year if you received \$2 a day than if you received \$12 a week? Assume there is not a leap year. Remember that there are 365 days or 52 weeks in a year.
- Ketisha buys 12 packs of sparkly stickers. Each packet contains 40 stickers. She shares these stickers equally with her 9 friends. How many stickers does each friend get if Ketisha keeps an equal share for herself?
